MEET OUR GUEST SPEAKERS:



David L. Allen serves as the Dean of the School of Theology at Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary, Professor of Preaching, Director of the Center for Expository Preaching, and holds the George W. Truett Chair of Pastoral Ministry. He and his wife Sherri have four children and one grandchild. Trusting Christ at age of nine he later felt God's call to the ministry at sixteen. He received the B.A. at Criswell College, Master of Divinity at Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary, and Ph.D. from The University of Texas at Arlington. During his ministry he has led over 250 revivals and Bible conferences including study tours in Israel, Oxford and Germany. He is the author of two forthcoming volumes in 2010: *Hebrews in the New American Commentary Series* (Nashville: Broadman & Holman) and *The Authorship of Hebrews: The Case for Luke* (Nashville: Broadman & Holman), along with numerous other articles and chapters in multi-author volumes.

Dr. Richard Mayhue: Senior Vice-President and Dean Professor of Theology and Pastoral Ministries The Master's Seminary; B.S.: Ohio State University; M.Div., Th.M., Th.D.: Grace Theological Seminary
Prior to enrolling in seminary, Dr. Mayhue served with the United States Navy from 1966 to 1971, including tour of duty in Vietnam. After seminary he ministered from 1975 to 1977 as an assistant pastor at Grace Brethren Church in Columbus, Ohio, where he also served as director of the Worthington Bible Institute. From 1977 to 1980, Dr. Mayhue taught in the areas of New Testament and Pastoral Ministries at Grace Theological Seminary in Winona Lake, Indiana, where he also enjoyed an active weekend Bible conference ministry. From 1980 to 1984, he was a member of the pastoral staff at Grace Community Church where he served as an associate to Dr. MacArthur in a teaching ministry and as director for the well-known Shepherds' Conferences. From 1984 to 1989, he pastored the historic Grace Brethren Church of Long Beach, California. Dr. Mayhue joined the faculty of The Master's Seminary in 1989 and was appointed as Dean of the Seminary in 1990. From 2000 to 2008, Dr. Mayhue also served in the role of Provost at The Master's College. Dr. Mayhue has authored, contributed to, and/or edited more than 25 books, including *How To Study The Bible*, *Seeking God*, *Unmasking Satan*, *The Healing Promise*, *What Would Jesus Say About Your Church?*, and *Practicing Proverbs*, plus numerous periodical and journal articles. He is active in Bible conference ministries and speaks in many churches and seminaries around the world. Dick has been married to his gracious wife, "B", for over 42 years, and they have two children plus two grandsons. Dick enjoys gardening, model railroading (N scale), stamp collecting (USA), and grandfathering when he takes brief breaks from ministry. He also enjoys speaking at other churches and conferences.



Dr. James Cecy: Founder and President of JARON Ministries International, a training ministry for Christian leaders in the U.S. and abroad from 1990 to the present; senior pastor-teacher of Campus Bible Church in Fresno, CA. Dr. Cecy was born in Toronto, Ontario, Canada and moved to the United States in 1961. He attended Cabrillo College from 1967-69 and then served in the U.S. Navy aboard the attack aircraft carrier, U.S.S. Kitty Hawk during the Vietnam War from 1969-1971. He committed his life to Christ in 1971. In 1973, he married his wife, Karen. They have three grown daughters and four grandchildren. They have also done foster parenting in San Mateo and Fresno, CA. Dr. Cecy began his pastoral internship at Twin Lakes Baptist Church in Aptos, CA in 1973. He graduated from San Jose State University (B.A. in Speech-Communications) in 1975. He became a licensed minister at First Baptist San Lorenzo Valley in 1976 followed by ministry at Grace Community Church in Southern California until 1978. He became an ordained pastor under Dr. John MacArthur at Grace Community Church in 1978. Following 12 years as a pastor/teacher at several churches in

California, he graduated from Western Conservative Baptist Seminary with a Doctor of Ministry Degree in 1992. Having spent most of his growing years, education years and pastoral years in California, he continues to serve nationally and internationally from that location. Dr. Cecy is also the author of numerous materials, study manuals and audio materials. He has been a conference and seminar speaker for hundreds of churches, schools, Christian groups and denominations throughout the United States and abroad. Because of his work through JARON Ministries International, he has become known as a "Pastor to the pastors."
